Establishment of “European Association of Quality Intermediary Organizations in Mobility” and project multiplier events

On 13.09.2018 in Brussels, Belgium the association “European Association of Quality Intermediary Organizations in Mobility” with official abbreviation EAQOM was established. The association is governed by Chapter III of the Belgian Act of 27th June 1921 on non-profit-making associations, non-profit-making international associations and foundations.

The international non-profit-making aim of the association is to define and promote responsible organizational, logistical, evaluation, validation and recognition practices in the planning, execution and follow-up of European mobilities in view of allowing mobile Europeans to benefit from international and intercultural exchanges, experiences, training and learning.

In order to gain wider publicity of the project results and products and to attract new members to the Association, small-scale promotional events (conferences) will be organized in all partner countries. the Project Final Valorization Conference will be held in Sofia, Bulgaria. The successful conduction of these events will be vital for creating awareness about the project and its outputs (the developed Quality Assurance System, interactive monitoring app, Association and its services) and to inform stakeholders on how they can make use of them.
